6. The following certificates will also be accepted:

- ✓ Completion of English courses in renowned educational institutions with a total number of 400 hours or more.
- ✓ Completion of English courses in Brazilian and foreign universities recognized by the highest education institution in the locality, with a total number of 400 hours or more.
- ✓ English language refresher courses abroad, attended for at least 2 (two) academic terms/semesters at an advanced level.
- ✓ In addition to the certificates above, we remind that students can obtain the qualification certificate at Feedback course, whose requirement is a minimum performance of 50% in the proficiency test in the English language, at the expense of the Graduate Program in Economics of EPGE/FGV, annually on dates to be disclosed according to criteria of the School.
- ✓ We also remind that, at their own expense, students can take the proficiency test at Feedback in order to obtain the qualification certificate, by means of minimum performance of 50% of the overall grade point average in the test in question, in the English language.
- ✓ EPGE/FGV Academic Board establishes the five (5) years prior to the date of the student's admission to EPGE/FGV Graduate Program as a valid term for acceptance of the aforementioned certificates and diplomas of English proficiency.
